Bike/Ped Safety Tips

- Cyclists on roadways or bike lanes are considered vehicles by Florida law and must obey all traffic rules to be safe, including riding with vehicle travel direction.
- Vehicles must give a 3 foot cushion (by Florida law) to cyclists in the roadway
- Cyclists riding on sidewalks or shared use paths should ride slowly, be courteous and give audible warnings and the right-of-way to pedestrians.
- · Lamps must be used on a bicycle after sunset to alert other drivers.
- Pedestrians and cyclists on the sidewalk must obey "Walk/Don't Walk" signs at signalized intersections.

Per Marco Ordinance 12 mph max speed limit on all sidewalks and multi use pathways
